



Scholarship Application Instructions

Spiritual Arts Institute (SAI) scholarship/work study programs are designed to help students complete the course of study in any of our training programs.

How the scholarship program works

Applicants are eligible to be awarded a scholarship to any of SAI's programs. They can cover from 25%-80% of the tuition fee. Scholarships can be applied to a complete program or to help with individual classes.

If student fails to pay balance due before each class begins, the scholarship would be forfeit from that point on. Students must keep pace with class assignments and maintain a high standard of excellence.

Scholarships for individual classes would break down in a similar manner. For example, if you were in the Seven Spiritual Arts Program, and wished to apply for a scholarship for an individual course (for example, the Karma and Reincarnation Course) a scholarship offered at 50% would break down like this:

Course title	Tuition	Scholarship pays	Student pays
Karma and Reincarnation	\$260	\$130	\$130

Awarded student is expected to volunteer time and/or services in SAI's outreach program. Details of this participation would be discussed in the interview stage of the application process.

How the work study program works

Spiritual Arts Institute offers a work study program. This program can be need or skilled based. It can cover a part or almost full cost of classes. Awarded students would donate their time and/or services in exchange for classes. The exchange would be completed within the time period the student is taking classes. Details of the work study would be discussed in the interview stage of the application process.

Incentive Program for New Students

This exciting program is designed to encourage new students to take the full Seven Spiritual Arts Program. This incentive would discount the first and last class 50%, essentially giving the student seven classes for the cost of six classes. Student is expected to volunteer time and/or services in SAI's outreach program. Details to be discussed in the interview stage of the application process.
